Student Qualifications:

- Currently enrolled BArch or MArch student
- Completion of BArch 3rd year with preference given to students completing 4th and 5th year studies or completion of MArch 2nd year.
- 3.0 minimum GPA with an excellent design portfolio, passion for building technology, and desire to learn about the many facets of the modular homebuilding industry.

Work Experience

The Clayton Homes Summer Internship provides a student of architecture the chance to be a team member in a national modular and manufactured home-building company. Clayton Homes is a vertically integrated company engaged in design, supply procurement, production, marketing, as well as retail, finance, delivery and installation logistics and insurance of their products. The internship will be structured as a series of “Exposure Stations” of varied duration to introduce students to a variety of activities and teams. These include:

- Costing Exercise with the cost analyst.
- Traditional Design project with an HBF (Home Building Facility) and design team.
- Concept Design Exercise using Sphere Trending Data with design team.
- Graphic Exercise with marketing and design teams, and potential ties to Sphere-based design project.
- Engineering and Code Exercise with the engineering team.
- Plant visits as needed and possibility for 1 - 2 sponsored travel opportunities.

Availability

Window for work experience falls between **May 19th and August 8th** and will be based at corporate headquarters in **Maryville, Tennessee**. Trips to local and regional manufacturing facilities are planned, and 1-2 overnight trips to more distant facilities may occur.

Compensation

\$12.00 per hour for 40 hours/week and a \$1000.00 scholarship.

Note: *Up to 1860 IDP credits can be earned during this work experience if/when work is under the “direct supervision of a registered engineer (practicing as a structural, civil, mechanical, fire protection, or electrical engineer in the field of building construction).”*
